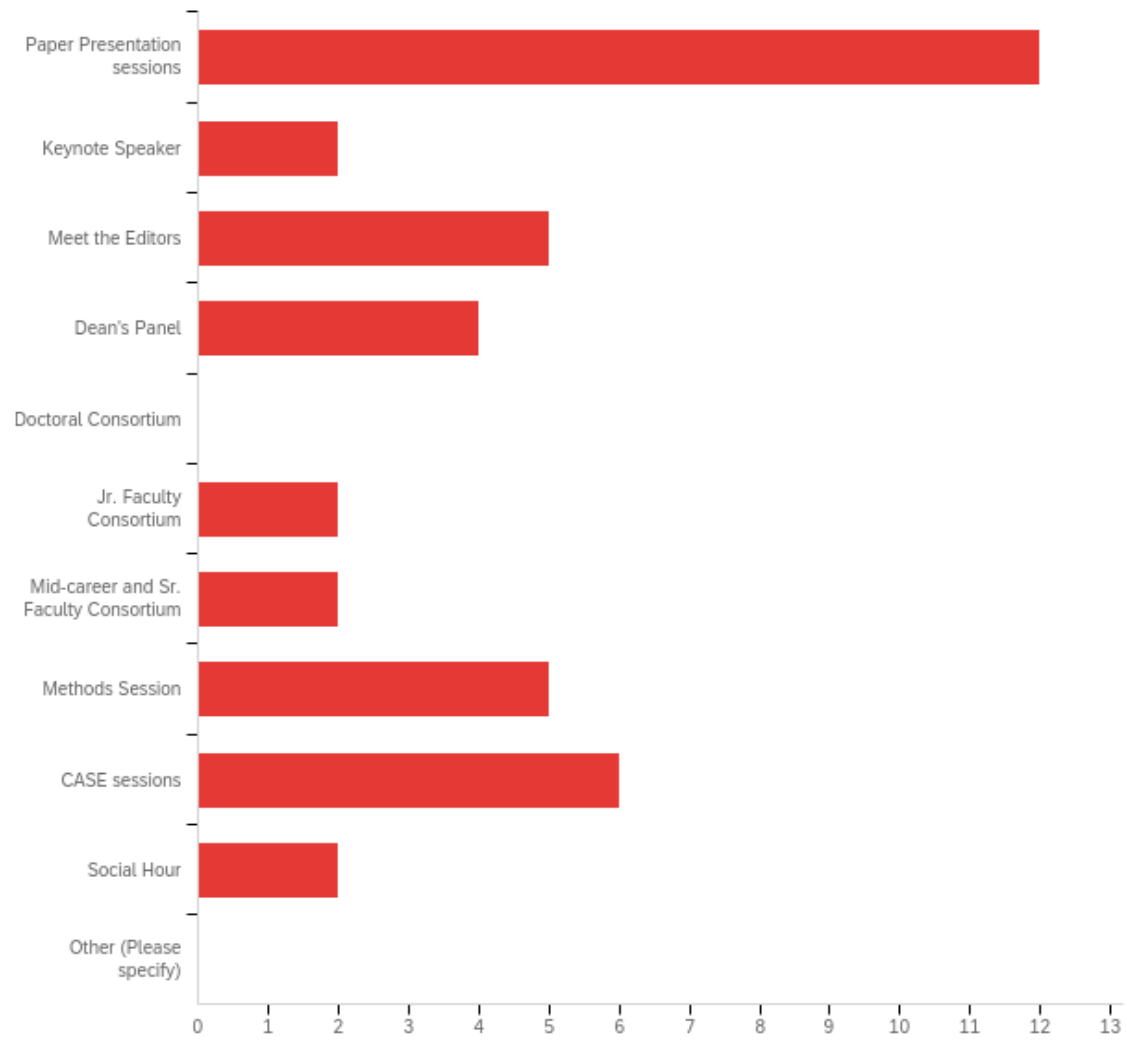


# EAM 2020 FEEDBACK SURVEY RESULTS

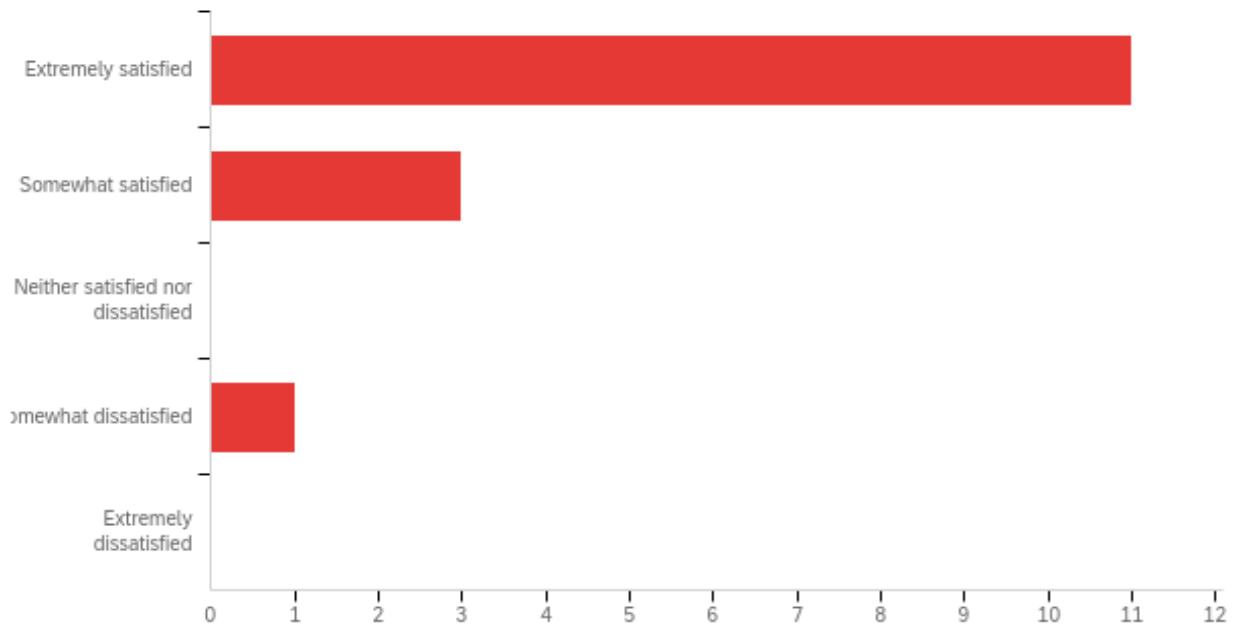
Q. What did you like most about EAM 2020: 57th Annual Meeting of the Eastern Academy of Management?

It ran very smoothly and we felt like it was a community of learning and exchange of ideas.

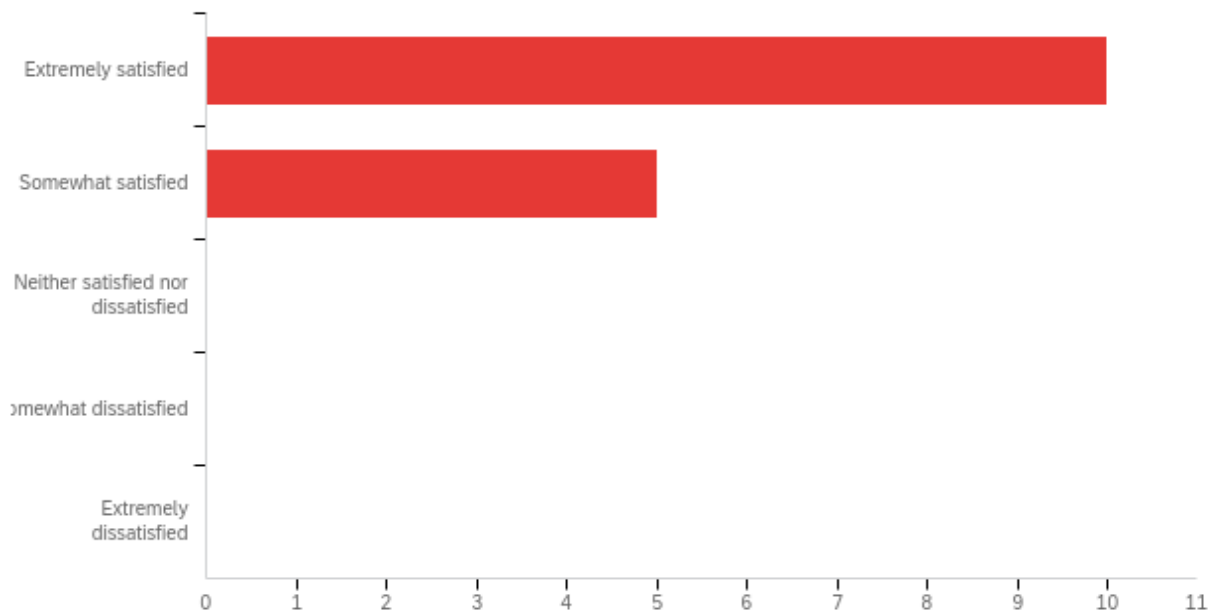
Q. In which of the following aspects of the event were you most interested? Multiple choice allowed



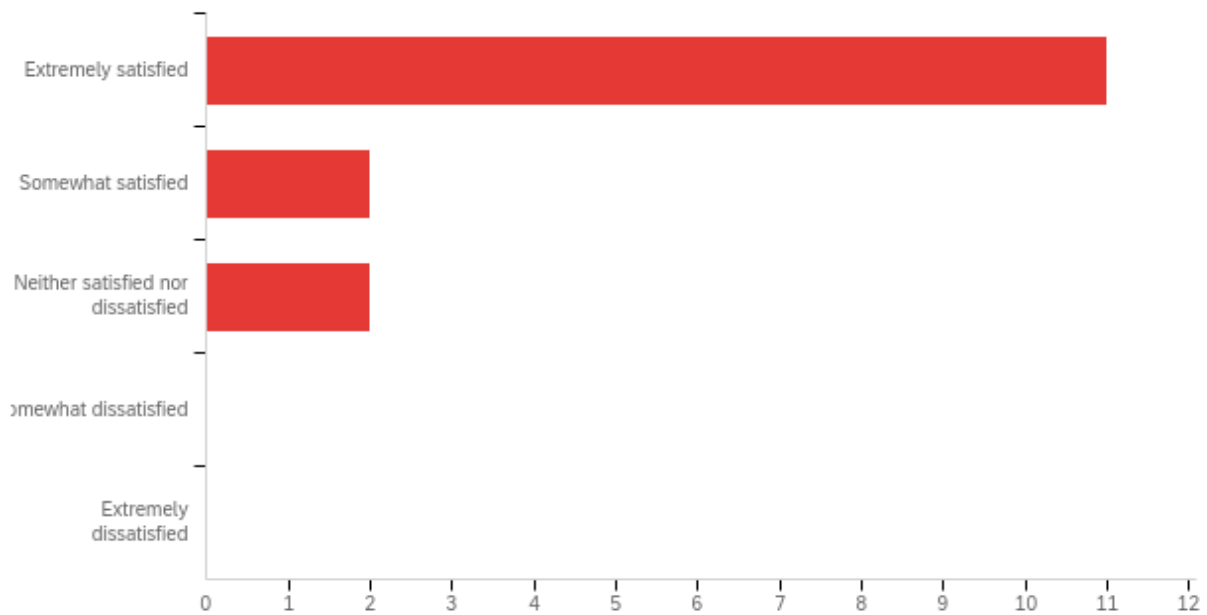
Q. How satisfied were you with the following: Zoom Meeting platform?



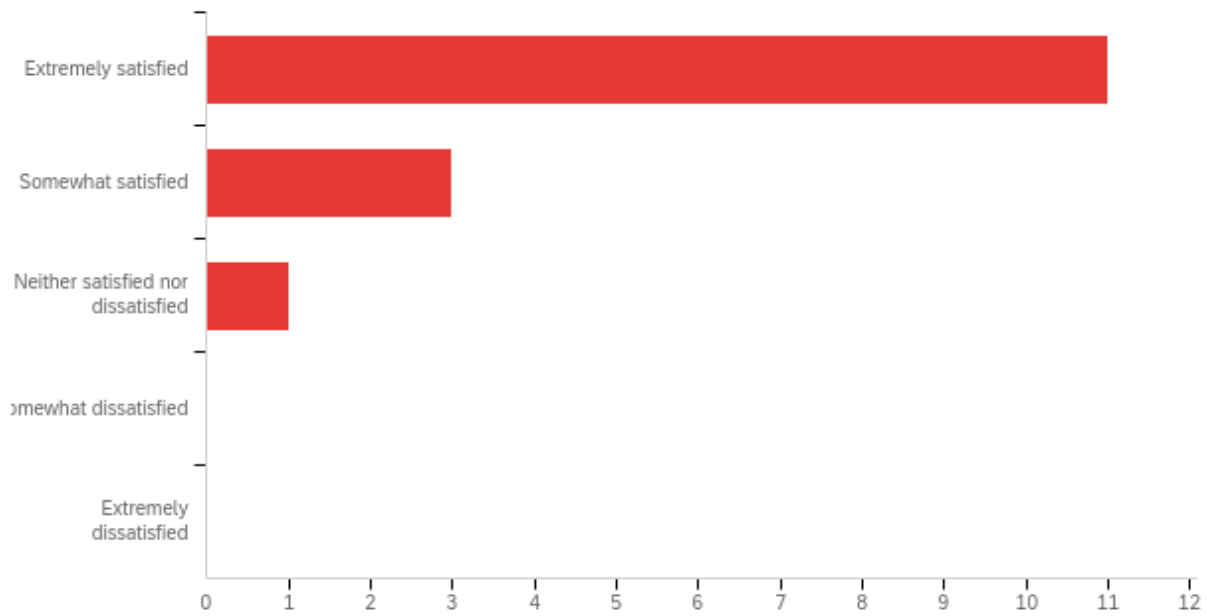
Q. How satisfied were you with the following: Length of sessions?
